Purpose: To express the Sense of the Senate on the export of oil produced in Alaska.

IN THE SENATE OF THE UNITED STATES

AMENDMENT intended to be proposed by Mr. SMITH of Oregon.

Viz:

1 At the appropriate place in the bill, insert the following new section and number it
2 accordingly:

3 SEC. ____ . SENSE OF THE SENATE ON THE EXPORT OF OIL PRODUCED IN
4 ALASKA.

5 (a) FINDINGS. – The Senate finds that –

6 (1) The United States is becoming increasingly dependent on imported oil to meet its oil
7 supply needs, with foreign sources of oil currently amounting to fifty-six percent of supplies.

8 (2) At the time of the 1973 oil embargo, the Unites States was only thirty-six percent
9 dependent on foreign sources of oil.

10 (3) Domestic oil production in the last decade has declined seventeen percent while U.S.
11 consumption has increased by fourteen percent.

12 (b) SENSE OF THE SENATE. -- It is the sense of the Senate that the levels in this resolution
13 assume that no leasing in the Coastal Plain of the Arctic National Wildlife Refuge shall occur
14 until the provisions of Public Law 104-58 permitting the export of Alaskan North Slope oil are
15 repealed. Such repeal would not, in and of itself, authorize oil leasing to occur in the Coastal
16 Plain.
