

Amendment by Senators Johnson, Boxer, and Sarbanes

At the appropriate place, insert the following:

Sec. ____ . BUDGET-NEUTRAL RESERVE FUND FOR OCS RECEIPTS.

(a) IN GENERAL. - In the Senate, aggregates, allocations, functional totals, and other budgetary levels and limits may be revised for legislation that would use proceeds from Outer Continental Shelf leasing and production to fund historic preservation, recreation and land, water, fish and wildlife conservation efforts, and support coastal needs and activities, provided that the enactment of that legislation will not decrease the on-budget surplus in this resolution for --

(1) fiscal year 2001; or

(2) the period of fiscal years 2001 through 2005.

(b) REVISED LEVELS. - Upon the consideration of legislation pursuant to subsection (a), the Chairman of the Committee on the Budget of the Senate may file with the Senate appropriately revised allocations under section 302(a) of the Congressional Budget Act of 1974 and revised functional levels and aggregates to carry out this section. These revised allocations, functional levels, and aggregates shall be considered for the purposes of the Congressional Budget Act of 1974 as allocations, functional levels, and aggregates contained in this resolution.
