

Amendment to be offered by Senator Johnson

At the appropriate place, insert the following:

SECTION ____ . SENSE OF THE SENATE ON IMPACT AID

(a) FINDINGS -- The Senate finds that --

(1) Impact Aid, as created by Congress in 1950, fulfills a Federal obligation to local educational agencies impacted by a federal presence;

(2) Impact Aid provides funds to these local educational agencies to help them meet the basic educational needs of all their children, particularly the needs of transient military dependent students, Native American children, and students from low-income housing projects; and

(3) Impact Aid is funded at a level less than what is required to fully fund "all" federally connected local educational agencies.

(b) SENSE OF THE SENATE -- It is the sense of the Senate that the Impact Aid Program strive to reach the goal that all local educational agencies eligible for Impact Aid receive at a minimum, 40 percent of their maximum payment under sections 8002 and 8003.
