anyone with a pre-existing condition, such as a dis-

1 ability or chronic condition, as provided under section 2704 of the Public Health Service Act (42 2 3 U.S.C. 300gg-3), as amended by the Patient Protec-4 tion and Affordable Care Act (Public Law 111–148); 5 (2) place a lifetime or annual cap on health insurance coverage for an individual with a disability 6 7 or a chronic condition, as provided under section 8 2711 of the Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 9 300gg-11), as amended by the Patient Protection 10 and Affordable Care Act; or 11 (3) allow a health plan or a provider to dis-12 criminate on the basis of an applicant's physical health, mental health, or disability status to increase 13 14 the cost of care, provide for fewer benefits, or in any way decrease access to health care as afforded under 15 title I of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care 16 17 Act. (b) WAIVER AND APPEAL.—Subsection (a) may be 18 waived or suspended in the Senate only by an affirmative vote of three-fifths of the Members, duly chosen and 20 sworn. An affirmative vote of three-fifths of the Members of the Senate, duly chosen and sworn, shall be required 22 to sustain an appeal of the ruling of the Chair on a point of order raised under subsection (a).
