7 (a) POINT OF ORDER.—It shall not be in order in 8 the Senate to consider any bill, joint resolution, motion, 9 amendment, amendment between the Houses, or con-10 ference report if the Congressional Budget Office has de-11 termined that it would—

(1) cause an increase in the rate of uninsured
individuals and families in rural communities by an
amount sufficient to substantially weaken the financial viability of rural hospitals (including small hospitals), clinics (including community health centers),
or other health care providers; or

(2) reduce Federal funds upon which rural hos-pitals and community health centers rely.

(b) WAIVER AND APPEAL.—Subsection (a) may be
waived or suspended in the Senate only by an affirmative
vote of three-fifths of the Members, duly chosen and
sworn. An affirmative vote of three-fifths of the Members
of the Senate, duly chosen and sworn, shall be required
to sustain an appeal of the ruling of the Chair on a point
of order raised under subsection (a).
