

TRUMP'S BUDGET WOULD BE DEVASTATING FOR HEALTH CARE

President Trump and Secretary Kennedy's health care budget brings more chaos and destruction to the Department of Health and Human Services, slashing its funding by \$15.4 billion, and gutting programs working families rely on.

- **Cuts funding for the National Institutes of Health (NIH) by \$5 billion or 10%**, slashing funding for lifesaving medical treatments and cures, including entirely eliminating three institutes and centers.
- **Decimates funding for the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) by cutting \$2.5 billion or 32%**, hollowing out the agency's ability to save lives and protect Americans from health threats.
- **Cuts funding for the Advanced Research Projects Agency for Health (ARPA-H) by \$555 million or 37%**, reducing pivotal investments to transform medicine and health.
- **Cuts funding for the Administration for Strategic Preparedness and Response (ASPR) by \$356 million or 9.6%**, including for critical programs that keep us prepared to respond to natural disasters and public health emergencies.
- **Slashes funding for the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) by \$437 million or nearly 11%**. CMS helps ensure over 100 million Americans have access to affordable, high-quality health insurance by overseeing Medicare, Medicaid, the Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP), and Affordable Care Act (ACA) marketplaces. This comes after the Trump administration and Congressional Republicans continue to undermine the ACA Marketplaces and enact deep cuts to Medicaid.
- **Eliminates the Agency for Healthcare Research and Quality**, imperiling efforts to support research into improving the quality and delivery of health care efficiently, while folding aspects of the Agency into the Office of the Secretary.
- **Eliminates the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA)** – the agency with expertise in tackling the substance use and mental health crises – while folding aspects of the Agency into the proposed Administration for a Healthy America.
