

TRUMP'S BUDGET WOULD BE DEVASTATING FOR OUR COMMUNITIES

Despite Republicans already providing about \$170 billion for federal immigration enforcement, President Trump requested another \$38.5 billion for ICE and CBP in FY27. These funds would be on top of the tens of billions that President Trump and Congressional Republicans plan to give these agencies through another reconciliation bill this year.

Trump is Using ICE and CBP Officers as His Secret Police:

- Trump's Budget request renews another **\$10 billion** for ICE on top of the agency's major **\$75 billion** funding boost allocated last year by the One Big Beautiful Bill Act.
- Americans don't want their tax dollars to fund Trump's secret police, yet ICE's annual budget has now grown to \$27.7 billion, which is more than the combined military budgets of Iran, North Korea, Venezuela, and Cuba.

Trump's Budget Means More Kids in Cages:

- Trump's Budget requests **\$2.2 billion** in additional funds for detention beds. Under the Trump Administration, the number of people in detention centers has skyrocketed. Last year, the number of detention facilities increased by over 90%.

Trump's Budget Harms Kids and Refugees:

- Trump's Budget request proposes **\$1.6 billion** in cuts to critical services for unaccompanied immigrant children and refugees.
- While claiming to reunite immigrant children with their families and protect them, the budget request proposes deep, unspecified cuts to the Health and Human Services program serving these children.
- Trump is also proposing major cuts to the Refugee Resettlement Program that helps refugees achieve economic self-sufficiency and prosper in their communities.

The Trump Administration is Sitting on Hundreds of Billions in Unspent Money:

- Through the One Big Beautiful Bill Act, Republicans appropriated **\$170 billion** in supplemental funds for immigration enforcement, including to ICE (\$75B), CBP (\$65B), DHS (\$22.5B), DOJ (\$7B), and DOD (\$1B).
- Per public data, the majority of these funds remain unobligated. Congress should demand a full accounting of those funds and rescind unobligated balances before appropriating another dollar for Trump's secret police, his brutal immigration enforcement, and his mass deportation agenda.
