Viz:

- 1 At the end of title IV, add the following:
- 2 **SEC. 4. POINT OF ORDER AGAINST LEGISLATION THAT**
- 3 **WOULD WEAKEN THE ABILITY OF THE DE-**
- 4 **PARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS TO DI-**
- 5 **RECTLY FURNISH HEALTH CARE TO VET-**
- 6 **ERANS.**

7 It shall not be in order in the Senate to consider any  
8 bill, joint resolution, motion, amendment, amendment be-  
9 tween the Houses, or conference report that authorizes  
10 funding for non-Department of Veterans Affairs-provided  
11 care, funded by the Department of Veterans Affairs, which

1 would reduce the availability of services directly provided  
2 by the Department of Veterans Affairs, including primary  
3 health care, mental health care, rural health care, and  
4 prosthetic care.
