AMENDMENT intended to be proposed by Mr. BARRASSO to the amendment (No. 5194) proposed by Mr. SCHUMER

Viz:

1 At the end of part 6 of subtitle B of title V, add  
2 the following:

3 **SEC. 5026 . MANDATORY ADDITIONAL ONSHORE OIL AND**  
4 **GAS LEASE SALES IN CERTAIN STATES.**

5 (a) REQUIREMENT.—Subject to subsections (b) and  
6 (c), not later than December 31, 2022, the Secretary of  
7 the Interior (acting through the Director of the Bureau  
8 of Land Management) shall conduct an oil and gas lease  
9 sale under the Mineral Leasing Act (30 U.S.C. 181 et  
10 seq.) in each of the States in which the Bureau of Land  
11 Management conducted lease sales in June 2022.

1 (b) PARCELS.—The oil and gas lease sales required  
2 under subsection (a) shall include, at a minimum, all par-  
3 cels—

4 (1) that were evaluated under the National En-  
5 vironmental Policy Act of 1969 (42 U.S.C. 4321 et  
6 seq.) process for the June 2022 sales; but

7 (2) that were deferred by the applicable Bureau  
8 of Land Management State Director.

9 (c) ADDITIONAL LEASE SALES.—The oil and gas  
10 lease sales required under subsection (a) shall be con-  
11 ducted in addition to the quarterly oil and gas lease sales  
12 required under section 17(b)(1)(A) of the Mineral Leasing  
13 Act (30 U.S.C. 226(b)(1)(A)).
