
AMERICA'S BUDGET PROCESS

From 1976 until 1999, Congress had never failed to pass a budget. Over the last 18 years, however, it failed 9 times to pass a budget, with only 1 budget passed in the last 6 years.





SPENDING BILLS ALWAYS LATE

The annual spending process has been completed on time only 4 times in the past 40 years. In fact, the average delay for appropriations bills has more than doubled.
