Viz:

1 On page 47, strike line 20, and all that follows
2 through page 51, line 7, and insert the following:

3 (c) INCREASE IN STATUTORY DEBT LIMIT.—The
4 Committee on Ways and Means shall submit changes in
5 laws within its jurisdiction that increase the statutory debt
6 limit by \$500,000,000,000.

7 **SEC. 2002. RECONCILIATION IN THE SENATE.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—

9 (1) SUBMISSIONS.—In the Senate, not later
10 than May 9, 2025, the committees named in para-

1 graph (2) shall submit their recommendations to the
2 Committee on the Budget of the Senate. Upon re-
3 ceiving all such recommendations, the Committee on
4 the Budget of the Senate shall report to the Senate
5 a reconciliation bill carrying out all such rec-
6 ommendations without any substantive revision.

7 (2) INSTRUCTIONS.—

8 (A) COMMITTEE ON AGRICULTURE, NUTRI-
9 TION, AND FORESTRY.—The Committee on Ag-
10 riculture, Nutrition, and Forestry of the Senate
11 shall report changes in laws within its jurisdic-
12 tion that reduce the deficit by not less than
13 \$1,000,000,000 for the period of fiscal years
14 2025 through 2034.

15 (B) COMMITTEE ON ARMED SERVICES.—
16 The Committee on Armed Services of the Sen-
17 ate shall report changes in laws within its juris-
18 diction that increase the deficit by not more
19 than \$150,000,000,000 for the period of fiscal
20 years 2025 through 2034.

21 (C) COMMITTEE ON BANKING, HOUSING,
22 AND URBAN AFFAIRS.—The Committee on
23 Banking, Housing, and Urban Affairs of the
24 Senate shall report changes in laws within its
25 jurisdiction that reduce the deficit by not less

1 than \$1,000,000,000 for the period of fiscal
2 years 2025 through 2034.

3 (D) COMMITTEE ON COMMERCE, SCIENCE,
4 AND TRANSPORTATION.—The Committee on
5 Commerce, Science, and Transportation of the
6 Senate shall report changes in laws within its
7 jurisdiction that increase the deficit by not
8 more than \$20,000,000,000 for the period of
9 fiscal years 2025 through 2034.

10 (E) COMMITTEE ON ENERGY AND NAT-
11 URAL RESOURCES.—The Committee on Energy
12 and Natural Resources of the Senate shall re-
13 port changes in laws within its jurisdiction that
14 reduce the deficit by not less than
15 \$1,000,000,000 for the period of fiscal years
16 2025 through 2034.

17 (F) COMMITTEE ON ENVIRONMENT AND
18 PUBLIC WORKS.—The Committee on Environ-
19 ment and Public Works of the Senate shall re-
20 port changes in laws within its jurisdiction that
21 increase the deficit by not more than
22 \$1,000,000,000 for the period of fiscal years
23 2025 through 2034.

24 (G) COMMITTEE ON FINANCE.—The Com-
25 mittee on Finance of the Senate shall report

1 changes in laws within its jurisdiction that in-
2 crease the deficit by not more than
3 \$1,500,000,000,000 for the period of fiscal
4 years 2025 through 2034.

5 (H) COMMITTEE ON HEALTH, EDUCATION,
6 LABOR, AND PENSIONS.—The Committee on
7 Health, Education, Labor, and Pensions of the
8 Senate shall report changes in laws within its
9 jurisdiction that reduce the deficit by not less
10 than \$1,000,000,000 for the period of fiscal
11 years 2025 through 2034.

12 (I) COMMITTEE ON HOMELAND SECURITY
13 AND GOVERNMENTAL AFFAIRS.—The Com-
14 mittee on Homeland Security and Govern-
15 mental Affairs of the Senate shall report
16 changes in laws within its jurisdiction that in-
17 crease the deficit by not more than
18 \$175,000,000,000 for the period of fiscal years
19 2025 through 2034.

20 (J) COMMITTEE ON THE JUDICIARY.—The
21 Committee on the Judiciary of the Senate shall
22 report changes in laws within its jurisdiction
23 that increase the deficit by not more than
24 \$175,000,000,000 for the period of fiscal years
25 2025 through 2034.

1 (b) INCREASE IN STATUTORY DEBT LIMIT.—In the
2 Senate, not later than May 16, 2025, the Committee on
3 Finance of the Senate shall report changes in laws within
4 its jurisdiction that increase the statutory debt limit by
5 not more than \$500,000,000,000.
